The number of rooms is followed by a column showing the average persons to a room, and two columns, indicating the percentages of families and of individuals living in each specified number of rooms. Taking up the table we find that in Baltimore 530 families, or 13.10 per cent of all families, live in tenements of one room, with an average of 3.15 persons to a room. In Chicago 5.87 per cent of all families live in one room, the average persons being 2.74. The per cent of families living in one room in New York is 5.62 and in Philadelphia, 12.10, with an average number of persons to the room of 3.13 and 3.11,...
